Minicross / Hoods Galore Allrounders Championship.

Round 2 – North Weald Sprint – 23rd March 2003.

The Minicross Allrounders challengers set off for the North Weald Airfield Sprint with Championship leaders Jeremy Evans and Trevor Stretch joined by Sprint specialist Charlie Whaley, 2001 champ David Hobbs, and 2001 runner up Scott Lawson among the runners.

The practice runs showed Stretch as the man to beat, with Whaley not posting a time – but he looked quick....

Sure enough, as the times came in for the first full timed runs, it was Whaley who blasted everyone aside by coming in with a stunning time of 1m 09.75 seconds, ahead of Stretch who was half a second behind. The rest were a further 2 seconds down at best, with Hobbs leading the chase, and Rod Stanniland, Paul Fidler and Jeremy Evans chasing behind.

The second runs were spoiled by an oil spill by another class runner, leaving Scott Lawson as the only Minicrosser able to improve his time, and Jeremy Evans having a large stop at the clerk of the course who had decided to send the Minis out to clear up the oily, cement dust mess that was left behind. No re-runs were offered to the Minicross class, which was bang out of order.

Whaley took the win, from Stretch and Hobbs. Jeremy Evans maintained his championship lead.

On arrival at the airstrip, the Minis looked like they would be left behind as Subarus, TVRs and Ferraris took their place in the queue for the runs. However, the Minicrossers were not to be outdone, with the first 8 cars posting times that were quicker than at least a couple of Ferrari 308s !!
