



2024 BTRDA CLUBMAN'S RALLYCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP APPENDIX 8 CROSS CAR AND JUNIOR CROSS CAR REGULATIONS

This class adapts the FIA Cross Car Regulations as per Motorsport UK Section N.2.17.7.

As per the Championship Regulations, competitors scoring in Junior Cross Car will not qualify for points towards the Overall 2024 Championship.

Changes in the FIA regulations are highlighted in yellow.

Competitors may compete in Cross Car from their 16th birthday. The minimum vehicle weight with driver in full racing apparel is 425kg, with a recommended vehicle power of 130hp.

Competitors may compete in Junior Cross Car from the year of their 14th birthday, and may continue until 31st December in the year of their 16th birthday. The minimum weight of the vehicle with driver wearing full racing apparel is 410kg. The power will be no greater than 75hp.

The minimum vehicle weight with neither the driver or full racing apparel and with the fluids remaining when the measurement is taken is 345kg. At no time during competition may the vehicle weigh less than this minimum weight.

Permitted exemptions from FIA Technical Regulations, as per Motorsport UK Section N.2.17.7.1:

1. The FIA homologated ECU may be replaced with the ECU specific to the series model of motorbike engine. The Championship (BTRDA Clubman's Rallycross) reserve the right to restrict this further.
2. The manifold and exhaust is free (J.5.16 and J.5.17 apply).
3. The series model of motorbike engine GSXR K is permitted.

2.4 – Only pump fuel is permitted, as per the Motorsport UK definition (See Motorsport UK 2023 Common Regulation: Nomenclature and definitions).

2.7 – No form of pit to car communication is permitted

14.6 – Clothing and personal safety equipment as per Motorsport UK regulations N5.9 to N5.9.6 inclusive. Fireproof underwear is advisory and not mandatory.

In addition – Fire extinguisher. Minimum requirement as per Motorsport UK Yearbook Section K.3.2.

For the purposes of this Championship, tyres are not free. The controlled tyre manufacturer will be MRF Tyres. The **only** permitted tyre for use is the MRF branded cross car tyre. Tyres must be purchased from Waltham Services – these tyres will be stamped to prove place of purchase and this will be monitored. Non-compliance will be considered a breach of these technical regulations.

The permitted Cross Car engines are as per Appendix 2, with the exception of Junior Cross Car.

As per appendix 3, the only permitted Junior Cross Car engine is the Yamaha MT-07. It must not exceed 75hp.
